Fall is here and we are ready for the girls that fill us up to capacity each year. We have been blessed to be able to freshen up our rooms while preparing for the new residents. Each year Saint Child has been filled to capacity and has a waiting list for young women eager to change their lives. We are praying about turning our sitting room into another bedroom to be able to house one more young girl this season. Please continue to pray for these young moms as they choose life for their baby and want to turn their lives around.

Fall has arrived and the veggies have been harvested.

We had quite the bounty of fruits and vegetables and now the vines are beginning to wither with the

cold morning temperatures. Since we are near the end of the produce season, we have begun leaving the front gate to the property open during the day.

The other day our case worker, Chris, watched as a coyote chased deer past the gate and onto our driveway. The deer seemed to recognize that there is safety to be had within the fence line. So we hope that young women who come to Saint Child will recognize the safe harbor that is offered here. We are once again in a nearly empty house as many of our girls have had their babies and have moved into either their own apartments or into transitional homes.

So begins the cycle of bringing a new group of expecting mothers into the fold. We are in the process of scheduling tours and are in anticipatory mode for the new girls who are to fill our rooms. Please keep Saint Child in your prayers as we work to bring in those young women who are ready to make big changes in their lives.

Cassandra has transitioned out. Casandra and Johnathan have graduated from Saint Child and have moved on. Cami had her baby in late September and plans on finishing her GED before returning to Colorado next month.
